We planted corn this year and the harvest was good. Most of it will go for the goats and sheep.

In September we had the Intermediate Training Course for a group of 20 Health Promoters. Veronica Palacios is the very talented woman who designs the courses and facilitates them. She invites two or three experienced Promoters to help give



interactive classes during the week. The women also form strong friendships. They ultimately serve their families, churches and communities. There are medical groups from the US they call Caravans and during the year the Promoters travel to help them out.



The week of the training in Tlancualpican at the Tree of Life Center they also had a Health Fair in a neighboring town where they taught about Diabetes and checked glucose levels; Heart health and took blood pressure; taught basic hygiene; taught all about dental care and more. It was quite well attended.

And the most interesting part was that we had a group from Brentwood UMC in Tennessee with us the whole week. Four people, two newbies and two who have worked with us many times, who participated in most of the Training, encouraged the women and form friendships with them. It was a marvelous week. They also visited families with straw-bale homes, they painted a building, they learned about the current state of the farm – like the livestock and spent time with the staff there and in Puebla. One member is a Pastor at Brentwood and she was asked to preach in Puebla and in Tlancualpican – she was great!



I’m going to mention again that we are fundraising for some new-used vehicles. Our goal is \$20,000 and we haven’t quite made it to \$4,000. Just saying!
