Although the "Give Ye Them To Eat" ministry (GYTTE) continues in Mexico, the Hendersons are retiring! We can't believe this time has come but it has and we are now going to discover what retirement is all about. We hope it will be as much fun and as rewarding as serving in Mexico has been.

As an integrated development program, GYTTE is all about <u>opportunity</u>; offering development <u>opportunities</u> to the resource-poor families in the rural sector of south-central Mexico. That is what you have been providing to disadvantaged individuals and families over the past four decades.
